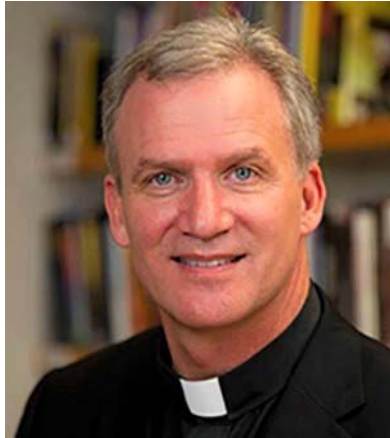

Fr. Dan G. Groody is associate professor of theology and global affairs at the University of Notre Dame and Director of the Global Leadership Program within the Kellogg Institute for International Studies, where he is also a faculty fellow. He is a Catholic priest, a Holy Cross religious, and an award-winning professor, author, and film producer.

Drawing on years of work on international migration and refugee issues, Fr. Groody has authored numerous books and articles. He is also the executive producer of several internationally acclaimed films and documentaries including *One Border, One Body: Immigration and the Eucharist*, and *Dying to Live: A Migrant's Journey*.

Fr. Groody has worked with the US Congress, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops, the World Council of Churches, the Vatican, and the United Nations on issues of theology, globalization, migration, and refugees.

*DYING TO LIVE: MIGRATION AND
THEOLOGY*

In his film with a similar title, Fr. Dan leads his viewers to explore who these migrants are, why they leave their homes and what they face in their journey.

We can expect to be emotionally and spiritually unsettled as Fr. Dan explores the factors that force people in these times to leave home in search of safety and peace.

As Pope Francis wrote on the occasion of the World Day of Migrants and Refugees in 2016, "Refugees and people fleeing from their homes challenge individuals and communities, and their traditional ways of life; at times they upset the cultural and social horizons which they encounter". Further he wrote: "We are to look beyond the inconvenience and upset that migrants can cause us. That people are forced from their homes by war, poverty, persecution and oppression should move us to act on their behalf with mercy."
